SHAC Activity Report:

- Wellness Plan and Bylaws Reviewed and no changes recommended.
- The number of students eating in the cafeteria this year had a daily average of 541 for breakfast and 903 for lunch.
- Sponsored Flu Clinic provided by The Apothecary and Hometown Pharmacy on 9/28/2021. Vax A Nation Mobile Health Clinic provided Flu Clinic on 10/12/2021.
- COVID testing was offered and performed by Superintendent, Mr. Duane Limbaugh
- Total three COVID-19 Vaccine clinics were offered and TXDHS sponsored, of which the last was for Pediatrics, 6yrs and older.
- Aim for Success Programs:
The Elementary School presented the Aim for Success program, The Big Adventure, to our students on Thursday, Feb. 10, 2022.
Covering *“the importance of mental health and tools to help them navigate life’s challenges”*.

The Secondary School presented the Aim for Success program, Focus on Success, to our students on Thursday, Feb. 24, 2022.
Covering *“the risks and rewards of technology”*.

Due to new Texas State Law, HB1525, districts are REQUIRED to obtain written consent for students to attend the any programs covering sexual awareness. This changed from the earlier “opt out” permission form that required the parent to send the form back only if they did not want the student to attend.

All parents were invited to a ZOOM presentation by the speaker, which previewed the program so that parents had an option to discuss and view the presentation.
